COVID-19 POLICY

Due to Coronavirus there will be changes to the way we do things in the setting to make it safer/healthier and adhere to the government guidelines

ARRIVALS

Only one allocated person to bring each student to the setting

Students to sanitise hands on entry

No food to be brought into the studio

Students to bring their own water bottles and water.

Any designated adult or staff to bring their own cup

Please wait outside at the recommended government Social distance.

USING THE STUDIO

Each Student will be allocated a seat, microphone with personal microphone top, microphone stand and lead. In some cases students will be asked to bring in personal notepads and pens.

All seats and equipment to be placed at the allocated government social distancing. Students are not permitted to touch the piano and other instruments.

Groups will be limited to 6-8 people.

There will be hand sanitisers placed around the studio.

USING THE TOILET

When using the toilet please wash your hands with the soap provided

Use paper towels and dispose in the paper towel bin provided. (PLEASE DO NOT PUT PAPER TOWELS DOWN THE TOILET) Paper towels will block the toilet and there will be a charge to anyone that disposes of their towels down the toilet.

When finished please spray the toilet with the cleaner supplied and also the lock/handles and anything else that has been touched.

DEPARTURES

Only one allocated person to collect student

Students to use hand sanitiser on leaving

Student to put microphone tops in the sealed bags provided.

All Students and parents to continue social distancing.

Staff to clean all equipment used.

Staff and Students taking ill throughout the session as per government guidelines

- Students becoming ill with symptoms of coronavirus are to be collected immediately.
 - The student will be placed in a designated area.
 - We must stress that all students who fall ill throughout the day must be collected as soon as possible.
 - Following the present government guidelines the student will have to self-isolate and will be eligible for a test to confirm if they have coronavirus.
 - If a staff member is to fall ill the same as above applies, but they will just leave themselves to get tested asap.

If anyone in your household has Coronavirus symptoms the student may not attend the setting under any circumstances.

WE MUST MAKE YOU AWARE IF THERE IS A SUSPECTED CASE OF COVID 19 IN THE SETTING THE WHOLE SETTING MAY HAVE TO SELF ISOLATE. THE SETTING WOULD HAVE TO BE CLOSED FOR FULL
